

For over 175 years our members have been helping people save money and buy their homes. Together, we're creating something bigger than banking - we're building a place where people matter.

Scottish Building Society Foundation - supporting our communities across Scotland

We know that charity funding from the UK and Scottish Government has been drastically cut in recent years and that the cost-of-living crisis has been catastrophic for many organisations.

That's why, in 2023 we set up the Scottish Building Society Foundation to support charitable causes and community projects, helping to make an impact and strengthen local areas - something that is deeply important to us.

Easterhouse Football Academy Glasgow

The football academy has used funding from the Foundation to hire pitches, enabling more children and young people to keep fit and active by participating in football training sessions and matches.

The charity initiative was set up with an initial donation of £175.000 and to date we have supported 28 causes across Scotland, helping organisations to continue to provide the services that really make a difference.

Here are just some of the groups we have recently supported through grant funding:

S.I.S.G. Enterprises Ltd South Ayrshire

We've supported the delivery of a monthly wellbeing cafe in Ayr for older people with sensory loss, where participants can connect with others and access practical advice and emotional support.

We've contributed to the cost of running community lunches and yoga classes in Kilchoan over winter, reducing social isolation and increasing mental and physical wellbeing.





Aberdeen City First Responders

Aberdeen

We've contributed to the purchase of four defibrillators to replace discontinued models and expand emergency response capacity in Aberdeen City.



Funding from the Foundation went towards the cost of a replacement polytunnel damaged in December 2023. This has allowed a protected environment to grow a wide range of crops which are free to harvest and for individuals to increase skills and connections.

These initiatives are just a handful of the good causes which have been supported since the Foundation began, and there is plenty more work to do.

A report by Foundation Scotland highlighted that by the end of our second funding phase, the 17 projects we supported have benefited an estimated 30,771 individuals.
